OVERVIEW:

The purpose of the position would focus on three of the suggested areas including:

1. Policy analysis
2. Business process development
3. Plain language use

MnDOT Aeronautics has broad enforcement authority for a variety of licensing, registration, and police power functions designated in Minnesota Statutes and Rules. The fellowship position will work with Aeronautics technical experts and Chief Counsel legal staff to develop evidence based business processes that define a path toward prosecution when compliance has been difficult to achieve.

Specific areas for process development include, but are not limited to; aircraft registration tax evasion, airport license denial or revocation, commercial operator license definition when UAS (drones) are the license activity, and Airport Safety Zoning obstruction misdemeanor citation.
